CBS Offers "Gargoyles" Tale

Gargoyles, as most people visualize them, are those grotesque figures — part human, part animal — that function as rain spouts for roof gutters on many buildings throughout the world.

The legendary creatures have been horrific subjects for paintings, carvings and literature from dozens of different cultures for centuries. But whoever in this day and age dreamed that they might actually exist?

Stephen and Elinor Karpf, one of Hollywood's most successful husband-and-wife writing teams, shared such a dream.

"Elinor was apparently so fascinated by gargoyles that she had a nightmare about them talking over the earth," says Karpf. "I helped her elaborate on the dream for a short story."

Producers Rick Rosenberg and Robert Christiansen helped the Karpfs turn their story into one of the season's most unusual television movies.

The result is "Gargoyles," a bizarre tale of horror and suspense, to be broadcast on "The New CBS Tuesday Night Movies" from 9:30 to 11 tonight on Channels 3 and 10.

Cornel Wilde stars as an anthropologist-author, who is menaced by hideous creatures. "We filmed 'Gargoyles' as a sort of valentine to that genre of horror movies that we used to enjoy in our neighborhood theatres when we were growing up," says Rosenberg. "We knew the monsters weren't really monsters but we didn't care. They were simply fun to watch."

"That's the same spirit we aimed for in 'Gargoyles.' We don't want to scare people. We just want them to have fun." Although gargoyles have been traced through centuries of art and architecture,

STAMFORD, Calif. (AP) — A team of Stanford University psychiatrists has developed a brainwave test to determine a person's sexual preferences.

The test provides scientists for the first time with an objective view of a person's arousal to a sexual stimulus presented in the form of a photograph, they say.

It is expected to provide a method for evaluating the effect of psychiatric treatment of child molesters and other sex offenders. The members of the team are Drs. Ronald Costell, Donald Lunde, Bert Koppell and William Wittner.
